Garth Fagan and T &T born Natalie Rogers-Cropper, dancer, choreographer, and director of the Gath Fagan Dance school. In 2023 she said "It's an honour [to be chosen for the scholarship] and it shows how far hard work can get you." A year after her return from the Garth Fagan Dance Movement Institute in Rochester, New York, she responded to a question about how her dance practice has changed since completing the institute: "I feel like being in the program helped with my flexibility as well as aiding me in getting my fouette turns. The turn sequence that was done in the [final] program taught me to spot properly. The program was quite impactful in helping me develop certain skills that I have now."
